

In Person Worship- We are open for in person worship with a maximum capacity of 50 people in the sanctuary. You are also welcomed to bring a lawn chair and sit outside on the front lawn (socially distanced) and listen to the service as it is being broadcasted from inside the sanctuary. You must wear a mask whether you are inside the sanctuary or outside. You are more than welcome to attend worship services if you are following all CDC recommended guidelines, as much as possible, and limiting your exposure to the Coronavirus/COVID-19.

Your health and well-being are our top priority. If you are vulnerable, ill, or have been exposed to anyone who is ill, or you are not comfortable going out, we encourage you to stay home and join us on the livestream. Live streaming will continue indefinitely so you can worship with your church family and be safe.

If you would like to come to church for in person worship, here is the process and requirements:

Registration is required in advance no later than noon on the Friday before the service you plan to attend. You may register at <https://pcmp.breezechms.com/form/753b2f9716> or by visiting the church website at www.mppresby.org and clicking on "Register Here" and filling out the form. You may also call the church office at **973-539-3481**. You are also welcomed to come on Sundays if you have not registered. However, once there are 50 people present, it will be on a first come basis if you have not registered by the previous Friday. Also, please be aware there will be no bulletins, hymnals, Bibles, prayer cards, or pencils in the sanctuary.

Please arrive no later than 9:20am on the Sunday for which you are registered. You must always wear a mask while in the building. **NOTE:** the door will be closed when the service begins and you will not be able to enter.

1. Enter only through the back door, where you will be met by a greeter and your attendance documented for contact tracing.
2. Proceed directly down the hall and enter the sanctuary through the open door in the narthex.
3. Sit only where there is an X on the pew. The X's are placed 6 feet apart and are in groups of 2 and 4. Only families who reside in the same home may sit together as a group. An usher will be available if you need assistance.
4. There will be no singing or responsive reading by those in the congregation.
5. There will be an offering plate at the exit from the sanctuary in which to place your offering and an open top trash can to deposit your individual communion cups.
6. The only open restroom is the one next to Westminster Hall. It will be cleaned often throughout the morning. Please wash your hands before leaving the restroom.
7. Westminster Hall will be closed.
8. Building access will be limited to the sanctuary and narthex.
9. At the end of the service, Pastor Don will direct you on how to leave.
10. If you would like to socialize, please feel free to do so outside while maintaining social distancing on the front lawn or in the parking lot.

If you answer yes to any of the following statements, please do not register or attend in person worship. Safety is paramount for our church family.

- I am experiencing symptom of illness such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever (a temp of 100 or greater), chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.
- I have traveled internationally within the last 14 days.

- I have traveled to a highly impacted area within the United States of America in the last 14 days.
- I do believe I have been exposed to someone with a suspected and/or confirmed case of the Coronavirus/COVID-19.
- I have been diagnosed with Coronavirus/COVID-19 and not yet cleared as non-contagious by state or local public health authorities.
